Rejoicing in Revelation #1 - The Source

- A. Seek to memorize the following Bible verse:
2 Peter 1:21: *For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.* ^{ESV}
- B. Answer the following questions about **Psalm 19:1-6**.
1. According to verse 1, what do the heavens declare? How does it do this? What does the sky above proclaim? How does it do this?
 2. What does verse 2 say about when the heavens speak? In what language does their message come to us according to verse 3? Where can their voice be heard according to the first part of verse 4?
 3. What example is given, in the end of verse 4 through verse 6, of how the skies so clearly speak to God's glory? What does this tell you about God' glory?
- C. Answer the following questions about **2 Peter 1:16-21**.
1. What does Peter say that they did not follow, according to verse 16? What does Peter say that they actually were?
 2. What were they eyewitnesses of, according to verses 17 and 18? What messages did they hear at that time?
 3. What does verse 19 say is more sure than being an eyewitness? How does it say that we should treat this?
 4. What do we need to know first, according to verse 20? What does this mean?
 5. Where then does the prophecy of scripture come from according to verse 21? What does this say for the accuracy of scripture?
- D. Answer the following questions about **2 Timothy 3:16-17**.
1. Where does verse 16 say that all Scripture is from? Since this is true, how valuable is it to us? What does it say it is profitable for?
 2. According to verse 17, what will Scripture make possible in our lives if we put it to use as it says?
- E. Application:
1. Would you say that you appreciate the Bible as you should? Why or why not?
 2. How has the Bible been good for you through your life? In what new way could you put the Bible to good use in your life?
