## Review & Study- *Kingdom Living: Prepping*

### A. Be sure you have put to memory **Luke 12:32**.

*Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.*<sup>ESV</sup>

### B. Answer the following questions about **Luke 12:35-48**.

1. Who is Jesus speaking to when he gives the instructions recorded in this passage? What difference does this make for how you should apply what he says?
2. What did Jesus tell his disciples to do, according to verse 35 and 36? What do you think Jesus was actually calling us to do in these figures of speech? How does this fall in line with his previous instructions that are recorded in Luke 12?
3. Who did Jesus say is blessed according to verses 37 & 38? Why is this so? Why might such servants not be prepared for their master's return?
4. What issue did Jesus present in his parable about a thief that's recorded in verses 39 & 40? Why might such a lack of preparedness become an issue for you? How are you to be sure that you are prepared when Jesus comes?
5. What did Peter ask Jesus, according to what verse 41 says? How did Jesus answer (vs. 42-44)? How does this apply to Jesus disciples?
6. According to verses 45 & 46, what did Jesus say about a servant that is not prepared when his master comes home? Why is this master so harsh? How does this apply to Jesus disciples?
7. What is the difference between the servants described in verses 47 & 48? What does this say for you now that you know your master's will?

### C. Application

1. Would you say, by the evidence of the life you live, that you are a Kingdom "prepper?" Why or why not?
2. What do you lack in your readiness for Jesus to return?
3. Does the thought of Jesus imminent return, scare you, concern you, or excite you? Why is this?
