## Review & Study- STAND-THE EVIL DAY

- A. Continue to put to memory **Ephesians 6:11**:  
*"Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil."* <sup>ESV</sup>
- B. Answer the following questions about **Ephesians 6:13**.
1. What is the "therefore" in this verse "there for" (what truths does it point you to)? What then does this verse tell you to do?
  2. To be clear, how much of the armor of God are you to take up? And, what will the armor of God make you able to withstand? And what will doing this allow you to do according to the last few words of this verse?
  3. In the world of the Apostles Paul's time on earth, what kind of person used armor? When did they take up all of their armor? How does this relate to a Christian living on the earth?
- C. Answer the following questions about **Ecclesiastes 9:11-12**.
1. What does "the Preacher" say about the swift, the strong, the wise, the intelligent and the educated according to verse 11? What reality causes these things to be true?
  2. According to the first part of verse 12, what do people not know? What is a reality for those who live on earth, according to the rest of the verse? Is this true for believers and non-believers alike? Do you think this is what the Apostle Paul refers to in Ephesians 6:13?
- D. Answer the following questions about **Luke 4:13**
1. What encounter is recorded in the verses that come before this verse? What temptations were presented to Jesus and how did Jesus respond to each of them?
  2. What then does verse 13 say happened? What does this say for the result of a faithful stand against the enemy? What does this say for the time frame of Satan's attacks? What does the last phrase say about Satan's strategy and tenacity?
- E. Answer the following questions about **Romans 8:31**.
1. What confidence does this verse give to a follower of Jesus who is or has been under attack by the enemy?
- F. Application
1. Do you see yourself as a soldier in God's army who has been deployed to the war on earth? Why or why not?
  2. How would you rate your preparedness for the oncoming attack of the evil one? Will you stand your ground?
