## Review & Study: REVELATION- PHILADELPHIA

A. Memorize **Revelation 3:22**: *He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.* <sup>ESV</sup>

B. Answer the following questions about **Revelation 3:7-13**.

1. Who were the first hand recipients of this revelation (v. 7)? Who is this message from? What do these titles/descriptions of Jesus say about him and his message?
2. What did Jesus say that he knows about this church, according to verse 8? What did Jesus set before them? What is this and what about this could they fully rely upon? What else did Jesus know about this church? Is this a good thing or bad? What did God strengthen this church to do, according to the the end of verse 8?
3. What did Jesus promise to do according to the first part of verse 9? What is likely involved with this happening? What will these “fake Jews” learn that is in contradiction to what they have held?
4. What did Jesus promise to do according to verse 10? What reason did Jesus give for doing this? What is the purpose of this “hour” that is coming?
5. What will Jesus soon do (v. 11)? What then does he call this church to do? What reason does he give this church to encourage them to continue in their faithfulness?
6. According to verse 12, what promises did Jesus give to those who conquer? What might each of these word pictures mean for the ones who overcome?
7. What are we to do with these messages to the churches (v. 13)?

C. Answer the following questions about **2 Corinthians 12:7-10**.

1. Why was the Apostle Paul given a “thorn” in the flesh (v. 7)? What did he say that this thorn was?
2. What did Paul seek to do about this hardship (v. 8)?
3. What did the Lord tell Paul according to verse 9? What then did Paul resolve to do?
4. According to verse 10, what attitude did Paul adopt in regard to his personal weaknesses and the other hardships that he lists? What reason/truth did he give for this?

D. Application:

1. What is one truth that stands out to you personally from this study?
2. What has been your view of your personal weaknesses?
