 3. What did Jesus say about the Ephesians according to verse 3? What about the city of Ephesus makes these actions so great?
 4. What does Jesus have against the church at Ephesus (v. 4)? What do you think this means? What are the ramifications of such?
 5. According to verse 5, what did Jesus tell the Ephesian Christians to do? What does “repent” mean? What will Jesus do if they don’t do as he said? What do you think this consequence involves?
 6. What did Jesus further commend the Ephesians for (v. 6)? Who likely were the Nicolaitans and what’s so bad about their works?
 7. What does verse 7 call for? Who would have ears to hear? What promise is given? What does it mean? Who are the overcomers?

1. What amazing abilities are presented in verse 1? What if a person with such abilities does not have love?
 2. What astounding gifts are listed in verse 2? What if a person with such gifts does not have love?
 3. What shocking sacrificial actions are presented in verse 3? What if a person gives this much but does not have love?
