Hidden risks of At-Home Chemical Abortions: After decades of U.S. abortions trending downward, our nation is now seeing an uptick. Experts say the increase is due to the growing popularity of at-home chemical abortions, rather than surgical abortions. Here at Pregnancy Hope Center, we are seeing more women actively considering this at-home method and it is very concerning. The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists reports that complications are 4x more likely with chemical abortion.

In 2021 the FDA removed enforcement of its patient safety guidelines for in-person dispensing of abortion medication. This allows women to obtain abortion pills without seeing a medical professional in person for an assessment of their health. Without an in-person consult, more women will take the pills outside the recommended timeframe, have undiagnosed lift-threatening ectopic pregnancies, and undiagnosed blood-type complications. To veil the risks even more, some dispensers of the medications tell patients that if they experience complications, they should go the ER and say they are miscarrying instead of disclosing they took abortion pills.

Pregnancy Hope Center will continue to be a safe place for women to consider their options, where they can be informed through ultrasound and medically accurate materials compassionately delivered by licensed medical staff and trained advocates who do not profit from their pregnancy decision.

GOOD NEWS - Eternal Heart Change: One of our client advocates met with a young woman who decided during her appointment to give her life to Jesus Christ. It wasn't the first time this client heard about Jesus here at Pregnancy Hope Center. But this was the day she responded with her own decision that she believes in Jesus and wants to follow Him. Our prayer is that her faith will be an ongoing blessing to her child and future generations. "I (Paul) planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth.
