Our core mission is to offer help and hope to women and men facing unplanned pregnancies through education, compassionate council and resources. We hope women and men will not only come to understand the medical facts about their pregnancy options, but also embrace the support available to them so they don’t feel a need to end their pregnancies.

In 2021 **PHC** started giving new car seats and cribs to graduates of our group Pregnancy & Parenting Classes. This is thanks to your generosity, a monetary grant from Pacific Power, and an in-kind gift of cribs from Klamath County Public Health and the ongoing cooperation of Klamath County Fire District #1.

Properly using an infant car seat decreases the rise of death/injury by as much as 70%! Other than failure to use a car seat, the most common problem in car seat safety today is improper installation. About 59% of car seats are installed or used improperly.

We are so thankful that Klamath County Fire District #1 was willing to partner with us to educate our clients. A certified car seat technician from KCFD1 comes to **PHC** each month to teach our moms and dads proper car seat use and installation.

Part of the parenting class program is a Family Finance Class, and a one-on-one budget meeting with our financial counselor. This helps new moms and dads learn practical budgeting skills and prepare for their family’s future needs.

With these incentives, 2021 attendance was back up to pre-pandemic levels. We had 62% more parenting class visits in 2021 than we did in 2020. These classes are important! They learn about bonding with their babies, infant hygiene, soothing techniques, safe sleep and so much more.
