Review & Study: REVELATION- LAODICEA

- A. Memorize **Revelation 3:22**: *He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.* ^{ESV}
- B. Answer the following questions about **Revelation 3:14-22**.
1. Who were the first hand recipients of this revelation (v. 7)? Who is this message from? What do these titles/descriptions of Jesus say about him and his message?
 2. What did Jesus say that he knows about this church, according to verse 15? What do you think this is referring to? How might this church have gotten into this condition?
 3. According to verse 16, what did Jesus say that he will do because of their condition? What might this mean?
 4. What did Jesus then reveal that the people of this church said about themselves (v. 17)? What were they not realizing, according to Jesus? How might they have become so far off in their self assessment? How would this wrong perception of their own true condition have contributed to being neither cold nor hot?
 5. What counsel did Jesus give them, as recorded in verse 18? How are these things that they should buy from Jesus better than what they had been valuing and depending upon?
 6. According to verse 19, what does Jesus do for people like these that he loves? What likely will such care be like for such people? What should they do to avoid this?
 7. How does Jesus picture himself in verse 20? What does this say about Jesus in his desire for these people? What will happen if this “door” is opened up for him to enter through?
 8. What did Jesus promise to those who conquer (v. 21)? What does this mean?
 9. What do Jesus’ words as recorded in verse 22 call for? Who has this ear to hear?
- C. Application
1. What one truth about Jesus from this passage do you appreciate the most?
 2. How might your church be valuing and depending on the world instead of Jesus? What can you do to help change this?
