## Review & Study: REVELATION- THYATIRA

- A. Memorize **Revelation 3:22**: *He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.* <sup>ESV</sup>
- B. Answer the following questions about **Revelation 2:18-29**.
  1. Who were the first hand recipients of this revelation (v. 18)? Whose words are these? How is he identified and what might these descriptions mean?
  2. What did Jesus say that he knew about this church according to verse 19? What do each of these commendations mean?
  3. What did Jesus say that he had against this church, according to verse 20? What does it say about what this woman was doing? Why might this church have tolerated such evil?
  4. What did Jesus say that he had done for this Jezebel according to verse 21? What did Jezebel do with this mercy?
  5. According to verses 22 & 23, what did Jesus say he was going to do? What will this communicate to all of the churches? What about those who did not learn from or participate in the practices of this Jezebel (v. 24)?
  6. What encouragement does Jesus give according to verse 25? According to verses 26 to 28, what promises does he give to those who conquer and keep his works until the end? Who are these conquerors? What is the morning star?
  7. What are we to do with these messages to the churches (v. 28)?
- C. Answer the following questions about **Mathew 18:5-7**.
  1. What did Jesus say about children, according to verse 5?
  2. What does he say about those who cause a child that believes in him to sin, according to verse 6? What does this tell you about how Jesus sees people who lead others astray?
  3. What do Jesus' words, as recorded in verse 7, say about temptation and the one by whom temptation comes?
- D. Answer the following questions about **James 1:21-24**.
  1. What does this passage call the disciples of Jesus to do (v. 21)? What does it say about us if we don't do this?
  2. What is the one who only hears the Word like (vs. 22-24)?
- E. Application: How can your church be more diligent about not tolerating those who lead others astray? What can you do to participate in this essential protection for God's children?
