Review & Study: **REVELATION- THE VISION**

- A. Memorize **Revelation 3:22**: *He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.* ^{ESV}
- B. Answer the following questions about **Revelation 1:1-3**.
1. According to the first line in this prologue to the book of Revelation, who is this book a revelation of? Where does it say that he got this information and why is this important to know? Who is this revelation for and what will it show them?
 2. How was this message made known according to the end of verse 1 and the start of 2? How do we know this account is accurate?
 3. What will happen to those who read this book aloud and what does this mean? What about those who hear the words of this book and keep what is written in it? What does “the time” mean?
- C. Answer the following questions about **Revelation 1:4-8**.
1. What does this “greeting” part of this book say about the human author and his hopes for the recipients? Who does this author say that he represents? What does he say about them?
 2. According to the second part of verse 5 to verse 6, what has Jesus done for his people? What does it say as a response to this truth?
 3. What will happen and how will people respond (v. 7)? Why do you think that people will respond in these ways?
 4. How does Jesus identify himself and what is significant in this?
- D. Answer the following questions about **Revelation 1:9-19**.
1. According to verses 9-11, how did the writing of this book come about? What are the significant elements of this occurrence?
 2. How does John describe the one who was speaking to him, in verses 12-16? What do each of these figurative descriptions say about the speaker?
 3. What did John do when he recognized the speaker (v. 12)? What did the speaker then do and say? Who is this speaker and what does he tell John to do? What is the mystery that Jesus reveals?
- E. Application
1. How important, would you say, that the revelation of this book is to Jesus’ church? What does this reality call for you to do?
 2. If you are amazed at the glory and goodness of Jesus and his works, what would be appropriate for you to do?
