B. Answer the following questions about **Luke 12:32-34**.

1. Who is Jesus speaking to when he gives the instructions recorded in this passage? What difference does this make for how you should apply what he says?
2. What did Jesus tell his disciples not to do, according to verse 32? What is the tone of this instruction? What reason did Jesus give for doing as he said? What is the "kingdom" that Jesus is referring to? Why would knowing this truth make a difference?
3. What did Jesus tell his disciples to do according to the first part of verse 33? Why do you think this is important? How much of your possessions do you think he wants you to sell?
4. What other instruction did Jesus give according to this verse 33? Where can you get money bags that do not grow old? How does one go about attaining a treasure in the heavens that does not fail? Why don't such treasures fail, according to the end of this verse?
5. What overarching truth does Jesus reveal next, according to verse 32? What do you think that Jesus means by the term that is translated, "treasure?" What do you think that Jesus is referring to when he says, "heart?" How do you see this statement being true? Why is the location of your heart so important to Jesus?
